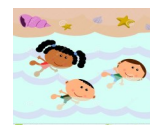

Everyday school matters

Requests from the office:

- ◆ When paying cash to the school for events or afterschool clubs, lunches etc, could you please put the exact amount in marked envelopes as there is no cash in the office to give change. If your child attends more than one after school club these should be paid in separate envelopes for each club because the organisers are not connected to the school
- ◆ Children are expected to be in school at 8:55am and morning registration is at 9:00am please do your best to get here on time as lateness is recorded on the BaNES system against the child's name.
- ◆ If you for whatever reason have to bring your child into school after morning registration or have to take them out before the end of the school day please remember to come to the office to sign them in or out. (it is a legal requirement from the government)
- ◆ As you know Reception, 1 and 2 are already being fed free by the government. If you have an older child and you think you may be eligible for free school meals please contact the office for information. If you are receiving any other benefits you may be able to claim for free school meals—and if you do the school benefits too

Remember to check all uniform items have your child's name in it! Please check your child is not wearing someone else's—already a few jumpers have travelled!
